Role

The student intern will be asked to increase robot utilisation, introduce more products through the robots, with justification, document processes and identify training requirements. Develop a controlled library of Core and Non Core CAD files and review other drawing requirements and recommend improvements. Look at automating transfer from Gate forms to Editing sheets, Process map current information flow and make improvement recommendations. Spend time understanding the manufacturing process and recommend and implement 2/3 significant improvements.
